Paul's letter to the brethren in the area around Colossae speaks of the superiority of Christ. These brethren were beset by those who encouraged tradition and philosophy and the observance of holy days and feasts. This focus on earthly things would pull them away from the freedom they had in Christ.

Paul urges them to focus instead on the things above. To keep their eyes and hearts on Christ by leaving these earthly things behind, along with the sinful attitudes that had ruled them in the past. They had died to the world and were now to live in Christ, following His teaching and example not the traditions of men. We need to follow this instruction today.
