# Replacing Christianity

As many in society give up their faith in God, Christ, and the Bible, they are missing the good leavening brought by the Word. *"The kingdom of heaven is like unto leaven, which a woman took, and hid in three measures of meal, till the whole was leavened."* (Matthew 13:33) One man explained that he accepted the 2nd great commandment — love neighbor as self — but rejected the 1st commandment — love God — because he did not believe in "the magic." He rejected the existence of the Supernatural, yet liked the rule about loving our neighbors.

Rejecting the divine person of God is calling for a whole new kind of religion, philosophy. There will be no "fear of God" for its adherents. (**Ecclesiastes 12:13**) There will be no ultimate accountability — what does it matter if we fail to love our neighbors as ourselves? They think the Bible is not absolute truth, and we can pick and choose what parts of it we like, if we don't abandon it altogether.

The byproducts of God's religion are good: things like discipline, honesty, work ethic, strong family, mental health, sobriety. Secularists want the byproducts without the real thing — faith and godliness.

Therefore, the humanistic approach calls for replacement morality, quotes and ideas from smart people rather than "book, chapter, and verse." There is no apology or quibble about teaching the outright doctrines of men.

So, I've been noting headlines in recent weeks to 1) document my case; 2) show how prevalent the new rules have become. There is a place for "*your own poets have said*" (**Acts 17:28**), but please understand that there is a great gulf between what men say and what God says. Jesus quoted Moses, saying "*have ye not read that which was spoken unto you by God?*" (**Matthew 22:31**) To read from Moses is to read what God has said. All Scripture "*has its source in the creative breath of God.*" (**2Timothy 3:16, ISBE**)
