#44 To God be the Glory

- Verse 1 To God be the glory, great things He hath done; So loved He the world that He gave us His Son, Who yielded His life an atonement for sin, And opened the lifegate that all may go in.
- There are many "great things" God has done
- Delivered Israel from Egyptian bondage
- Moses praised Him for that deliverance Exodus 15:1-18
- Psalmist offers praise for the things God has done and encourage us to tell of them Psalm 78:1-4 The sacrifice of The Son is worthy of glory
- Paul said it was his only boast Galatians 6:11-16
- Question regarding "all may go in" with focus on "all."
 - Not all will gain the salvation provided by the death of Jesus, but the opportunity (may) is available to all
 - He opened the gate so that "whosoever will may come" 2Peter 3:9
 - Jesus died for all mankind John 3:16
- **Verse 2** O perfect redemption, the purchase of blood, To ev'ry believer the promise of God; The vilest offender who truly believes, When buried with Jesus a pardon receives.
- (Originally "That moment from Jesus a pardon receives." which has Calvinistic tones) The revelation of God's eternal plan through Jesus should cause us to glorify God - Romans 16:25-27
- Redemption thru blood of Christ able to save vilest offender Hebrews 9:12-15; 1Timothy 1:12-16
- **Verse 3** Great things He hath taught us, great things He hath done, And great our rejoicing thru Jesus the Son; But purer and higher, and greater will be Our wonder, our transport, when Jesus we see.
- The Word of God reveals all we need to be ready for eternity **2Timothy 3:14-17** Paul speaks of the great and wonderful blessings we have received through Jesus - **Ephesians 1:3–14** Understanding these we should rejoice in the Lord - **Philippians 4:4-7**
- But even that joy will pale in comparison to the joy of going with Him to Glory **1John 2:28-3:3**
- **Chorus** Praise the Lord, Praise the Lord, Let the earth hear His voice! Praise the Lord, praise the Lord, Let the people rejoice! O come to the Father thru Jesus the Son, And give Him the glory great things He hath done.
 - Our studies in Nehemiah reveals calls to praise God for what He has done Nehemiah 9:5 The Psalmist calls for Praise to the Lord - Psalm 145
